Entry Limit:

Maximum individual entries per athlete: 5

Maximum relay entries per athlete: 4

Qualification:

All athletes must be registered with the Lifesaving Society. For SERC participants must be 14 years of age or older

Entry Fee:

- \$20 per athlete for Friday only
- \$45 per athlete for Saturday only
- \$60 per athlete for Friday and Saturday

Entry Procedure:

Lifesaving Sport Coaches must submit entries through <http://sport.lifesaving.org>.

Scoring:

Scoring for the events shall occur in accordance with the Alberta and NWT Competition Manual, 2022 Edition.

Awards:

Ribbons may be awarded to those in 1st through 6th place, male and female in each age group.

Warm Up Information:

Warm ups for Friday will start at 5:00pm with no lane assignments. The warm-up length will be 15 minutes. Dives will commence at 5:15pm in Lane 1 or 8 only and for 10-minutes.

Warm ups for Saturday will be completed in 30-minute blocks starting at 6:45am. Dive practice will be held in accordance with the safety warm-up procedures and will be completed in the last 10 minutes of each warm-up block.

Seeding:

Competitors shall be seeded for each event based on entry times submitted with registration.

Coaches Meeting:

On the Friday, the coaches meeting will be held at 5:15pm. On the Saturday, the coaches meeting will be held at 7:30am.

Deck Entries:

Deck entries will be permitted provided they do not require the addition of another heat. Entries will be seeded into empty lanes in existing heats.

There will be no deck entries for SERC.

Relay Changes:

Relay Changes shall be submitted no later than thirty (30) minutes prior to the start of each session hosting the relay event(s).

Scratches:

All efforts are appreciated to inform the Clerk of Course of any scratches no later than 30 minutes prior to the start of the event.
