Seeding:

Deck Entries:

Deck entries will be permitted provided they do not require the addition of another heat. Entries will be seeded into empty lanes in existing heats.

There will be one session of warm ups of 25 minutes with the last 5 minutes being open for dive practice. Teams will be assigned warm up times and lanes prior to the meet after registration has closed.
