Code of Conduct: *Updated*

All volunteers, officials, competitors, and coaches should adhere to the Codes of Conduct outlined in the most current Canadian Competition Manual and ILS Competition Rule Book. The Management Committee will be responsible for enforcement of these codes. Anyone not adhering to the safety procedures as prescribed in the Canadian Competition

Manual and ILS Competition Rule Book may be disqualified or removed from the property. Unsafe actions and behaviors will not be tolerated.

Contingency Plans:

All contingency plans are decided by the Management Committee. The committee has the right to postpone, reschedule, or cancel an event or competition if the venue is deemed unsafe.

Emergency Procedures: *Updated* 2023-01-28

The Kinsmen Aquatic Centre facility staff will notify the appointed Lifesaving Society Safety Officer of any major incident that occurs on site including any drowning, resuscitation, suspected spinal injury and possible fracture.

The Kinsmen Aquatic Centre will be supervised by certified Lifesaving Society National Lifeguards employed by the Kinsmen Aquatic Centre. Employees will deal with emergencies as per the Kinsmen Aquatic Centre emergency procedures. The Management Committee will assist with managing the competition participants and volunteers during an emergency.

General Safety: *Updated* 2019-08-07

- The Lacombe Kinsmen Aquatic Centre will adhere to the Alberta Legislation and Regulations as well as facility specific rules that will be followed for patron safety.
- Certified Lifesaving Society National Lifeguards will be supplied by the facility for the duration of the event.
- All general rules and procedures pertaining to competitions can be found in the most current Canadian Competition Manual.

Major-Minor Incidents: *Updated* 2023-01-28

Lacombe Kinsmen Aquatic Centre staff will notify the appointed Lifesaving Society Safety Officer of any major incident that occurs on site including any drowning, resuscitation, suspected spinal injury and possible fracture.

The Lacombe Kinsmen Aquatic Centre Management Committee has a safety and emergency plan for:

- The general safety of athletes, competition personnel and spectators during the competition.
- The City of Lacombe personnel and procedures are in place in case of minor or major incidents involving injury or illness of competitors, competition personnel and spectators.

The following overview will outline the facility that will be utilized during the 2020 Lacombe Kinsmen Aquatic Centre Competition. It will clearly identify those authorized persons to initiate the Safety and Emergency Plan and outline command and control functions.

General procedures can be found outlined in the parents handout with the Safety Officer, in conjunction with Alberta Legislation and Regulations pertaining to pool operations.

The Host has a designated Safety Officer. The designated Safety Officer is to liaise with the Lacombe Kinsmen Aquatic Centre staff in regards to competition safety. The LacombeKinsmen Aquatic Centre will be required to report and document any incidents that occur at the facility during the event.

Lacombe Kinsmen Aquatic Centre staff will be responsible for initiating the Lacombe Kinsmen Aquatic Centre's Emergency Safety Plan.
